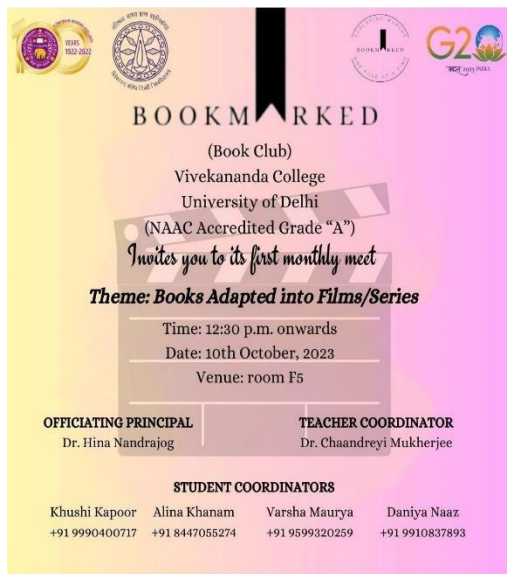
Title of Event: Books Adapted into Film/Series

Bookmarked, the book club of Vivekananda College, University of Delhi held its first session on the theme 'Books Adapted into Film/Series' on 10 October, 2023, in Room F5 of the college. The introduction of the student coordinators was given at the beginning followed by the procedure of how the book club will function. The audience was asked to give their introduction along with their thoughts for the given theme. After the introduction, an interactive game was introduced named *book-charades* in which the audience was divided into two teams named *mean girls* and *gossip girls* and one by one each member from each team was asked to impersonate the movies given by the student coordinators to their respective teams. The session received enthusiastic participation from the audience. The student coordinators for the session were Alina and Varsha. Under the constant guidance and support of the teacher coordinator Dr. Chaandreyi Mukherjee, the session was hailed a success.



1b. Title of Event: Educational Tour

An **Educational Tour** to a few Delhi Monuments was undertaken on 06.03.2024. A group of 17 BA prog students were accompanied by 02 teachers, Prof. Yuthika Mishra and Ms. Gopika Bhandari. The Van was provided by the college. The objective of the tour was to provide an overview of Delhi's history to the students. The group first visited Firoz Shah Kotla, the highlights being the the Kotla mosque and the Ashokan pillar located on the premises. Subsequently the students visited the Tughlaqabad mausoleum, constructed of finely cut red sandstone and white marble, which houses Ghiasuddin's tomb along with that of his son and wife. After that, the remarkable, massive stone fortifications of Tughlaqabad fort drew everyone's attention and the group explored many structures located inside including the Vijaymandal. The students also gained a glimpse of the Adilabad fort as well as the Nai ka Kot located at a short distance from there. The last to be visited was the Mehrauli complex in the heart of the Quila Rai Pithora. Around the Qutb the students studied important monuments like the Mehrauli pillar of Chandragupta II Vikramaditya, the remains of the temples, the Minar itself, Iltutmish's tomb, the magnificent Alai darwaza and Alauddin's Madarsa.



1c. Excursion Trip to Jim Corbett National Park-Nainital

A four-day excursion trip from 4th October to 7th October 2024 to Jim Corbett National Park-Nainital was organized by the Department of Commerce for 2nd and 3rd year 43 commerce students along with Teacher In-charge Dr. Subhashree Bose, and faculty members, Dr. Shafaq Zareen, Ms. Shilpa, Ms. Shivani Kalra and Ms. Meenu to promote learning through outdoor experiences. The next day started with an early morning jungle safari which was a wonderful experience of driving through the dense forest and sighting animals. In the afternoon students visited Garjiya temple, a famous tourist attraction and enjoyed at Kosi River till late evening. The last day faculty with students went for a walk where they experienced hot air ballooning and ATV ride. After this fantastic experience we started early for Nainital and on the way we visited Jim Corbett Museum. The Jim Corbett Museum was also an exceptional attraction where they observed and experienced the life of Sir Jim Corbett. After this, we started off for Nainital. In Nainital students visited Naina Devi Temple and Tibetan market where they shopped for their family and friends. Students also enjoyed garba and dandiya in the local Dussehra festival night. After a fun filled evening, we departed for college and this trip ended with lots of memories.

1d. Industrial Visits

On 18th April 2024, an Entrepreneurship Orientation Program (EOP) cum Industrial Visit to National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC), Okhla was organized for the students of B.Com 2nd year as part of their curriculum. The students were accompanied by Dr. Shafaq Zareen, Ms. Rachna Megh and Ms. Sakshi Meena. The session was conducted by Ms. Uzma Mumtaz, Entrepreneurship Mentor, NSIC. The students were given an insight about the working of NSIC, its role for new startups, easy to implement strategies, reasons for failure of start-ups and various Government schemes to promote and support new entrepreneurs. The visit included a tour of the incubator center of NSIC, where students get a live demonstration of making tissue paper rolls, paper napkin, paper plate making, pet bottle making, spice grinder machine for grinding spices, bread making machine, biscuit making, garlic paste making etc. Various aspects of it like cost per unit, production, operation and packaging was discussed. Another division which focuses on fashion designing and make-up training specially for women entrepreneurs was also demonstrated by the NSIC staff. The visit concluded on a positive note as students got hands on experience.

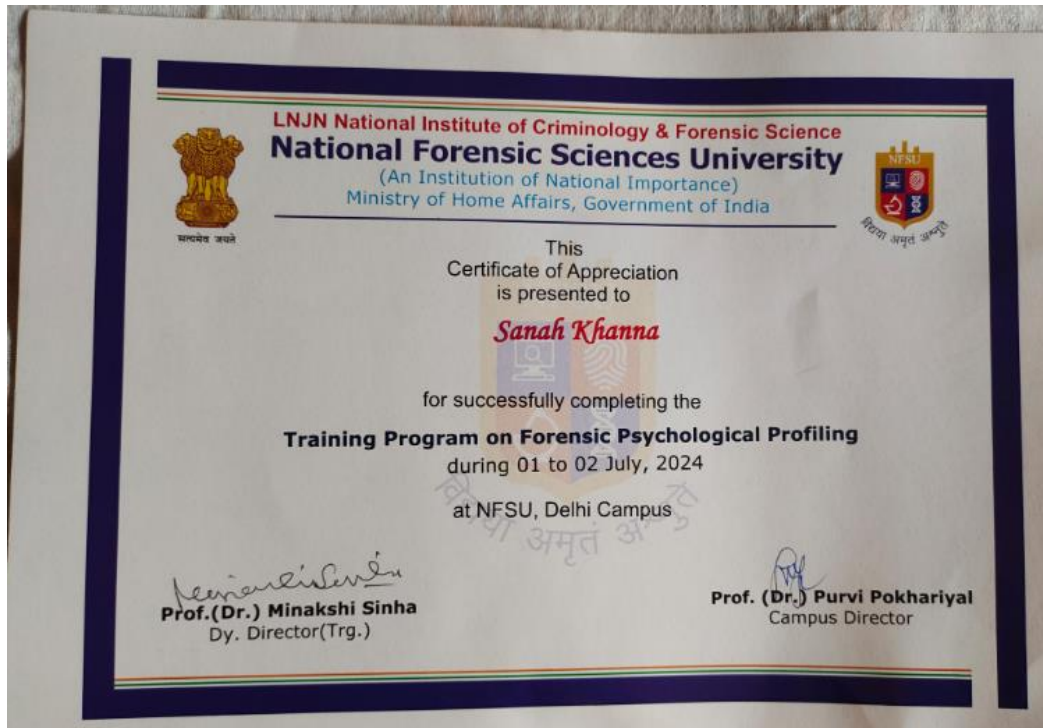
