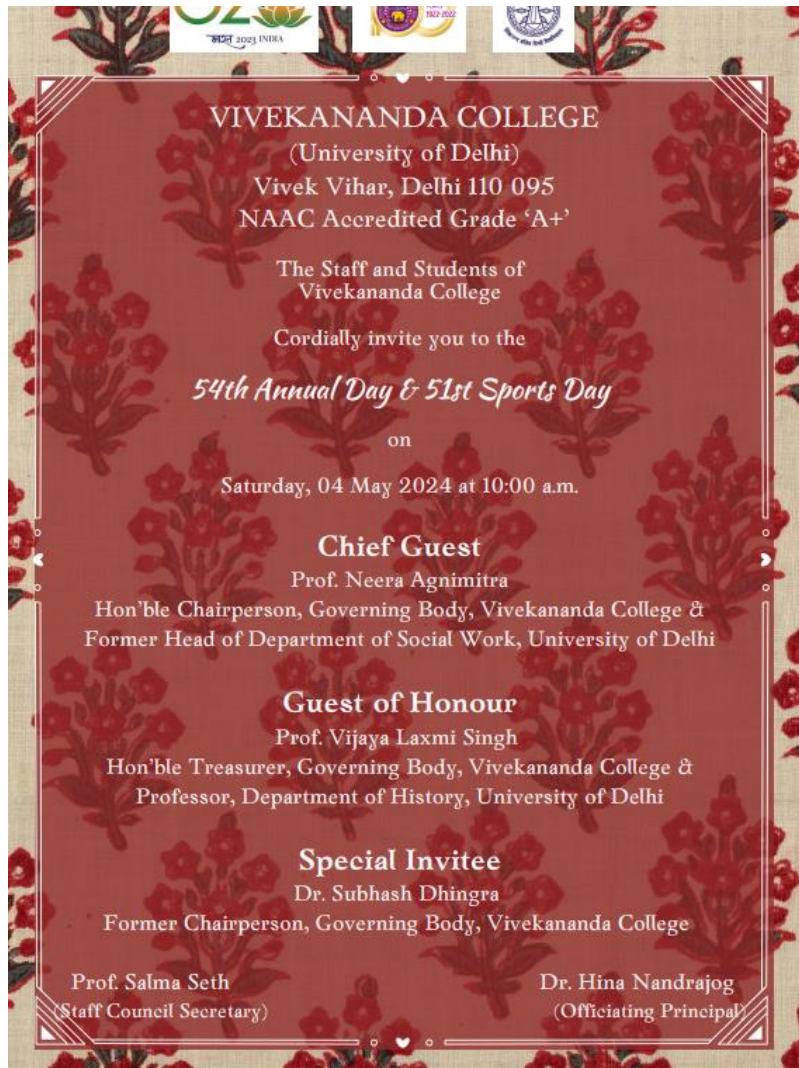

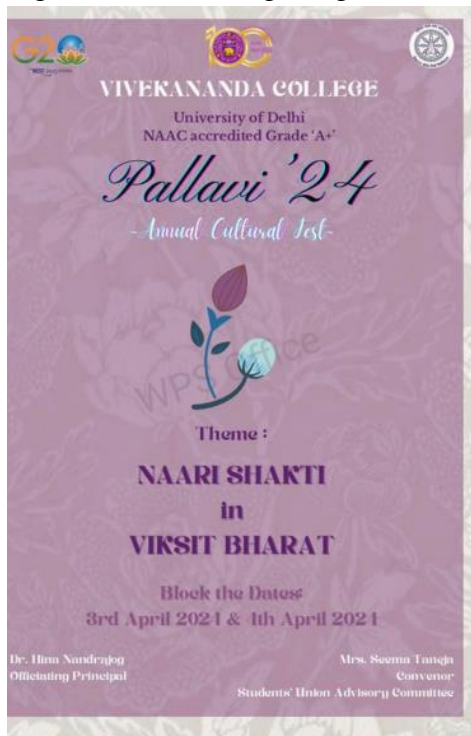

Day 2 highlights included family performances, street plays, debates on *E-Swaraj*, poetry competitions, creative writing, sustainability presentations, corporate error challenges, folk and western dances, and photography contests. 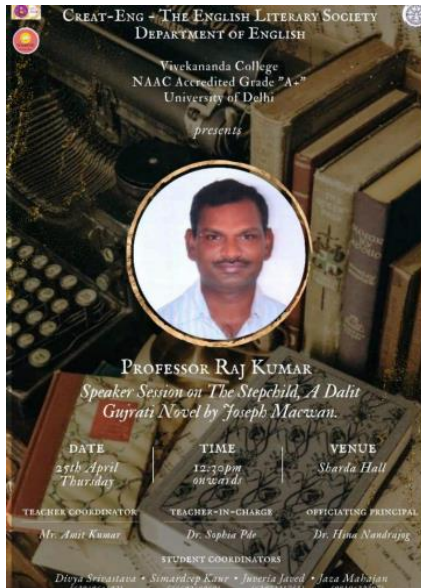


4) **Prabha 2.0: A Grand Carnival by Team Enactus VNC.** On April 9, 2024, Team Enactus of Vivekananda College, under the guidance of Dr. Sandhya Jain (Convenor) and Dr. Shafaq Zareen (Faculty Coordinator), hosted *Prabha 2.0*, a vibrant carnival celebrating creativity and culture. Inspired by “*Purani Dilli*” and aligned with their project *ECOture – From Waste to Wardrobe*, the event preserved the essence of traditional embroidery and artistry, attracting over 2500 attendees. The carnival featured 20 diverse stalls from small-scale businesses and Enactus teams across Delhi University, offering cuisines, games, and cultural experiences. Activities like hair braiding, face painting, tarot readings, block painting, and chart corners immersed participants in

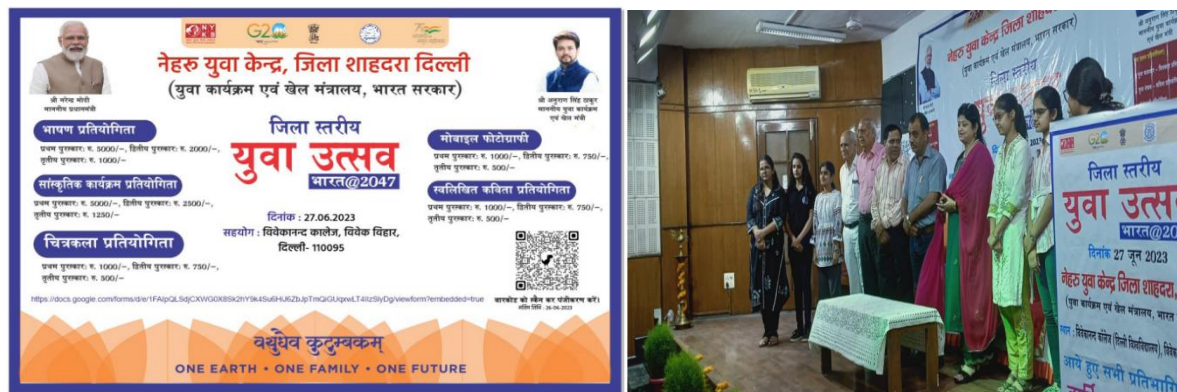

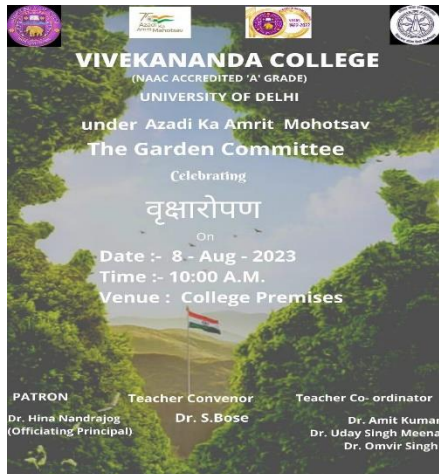

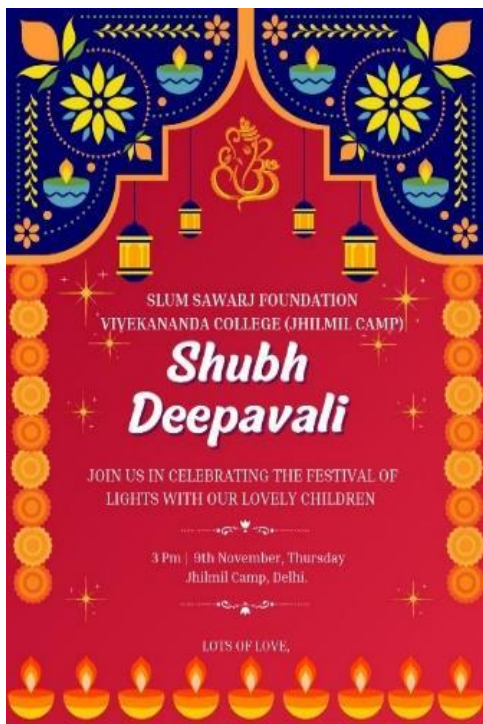
