### **Rules for Competitions**

Following competitions open only for all UG students will be held on 30 September 2024 in Vivekananda College:

- Painting
- Poster making
- Photography
- 2-min videos
- Nukkad Naatak

Students must carry their ID cards at the venue of competition.

All participants must also register themselves. There is no fees for student registration. Last date for registration: 20 September 2024

### **General Rules for all competitions**

- English or Hindi can be used for creating the content

- Participants are responsible for bringing their own material including A3 size paper, cameras, and other materials
- Submissions will be evaluated on creativity, thematic relevance, quality, and overall impact
- All submissions must be original and not have any inappropriate or offensive content
- The decision of the judges will be final and binding

**In addition, there are specific rules given for each competition given as follows:**

#### **Rules for Painting Competition and poster making**

1. Participants have full freedom to utilize any mediums, techniques, and styles for their paintings.
1. Paintings/posters must be created on the spot, based on the theme provided by the organizers at the start of the competition.
2. The dimensions of the painting/poster must adhere to A3 size paper.
3. The allotted time for painting will be 90 minutes.

#### **Rules for photography competition**

2. Each participant can submit only one photograph that should be original.
3. The photograph must be captured on the spot during the allotted time, based on the theme provided by the organizers at the start of the competition.
4. Participants will have 90 minutes to capture and submit their photograph.
5. Photographs must be submitted in digital format, either in JPEG or PNG format.
6. File size should not exceed 20 MB.
7. Basic editing, including color correction, cropping, and sharpening, is allowed but excessive editing that alters the reality of the photograph will lead to disqualification.

#### **Rules for 2-min video**

1. Each participant can submit only one video which will be made on the spot based on the theme given by the organizers at the start of the competition.
2. The video must be exactly 2 minutes long. Videos exceeding or falling short of the 2-minute duration will be penalized.
3. 90 minutes will be given to make the video.
4. The file size should not exceed 500 MB.
5. Participants can use video editing software to enhance their videos.

#### **Rules for Nukkad Naatak**

1. Each team must consist of a minimum of 7 and a maximum of 10 members and can perform only one street play on the theme 'aging in the digital era'.
2. The maximum time allotted for each performance is 10 minutes.
3. The performance will take place in an open area designated by the organizers.

#### **Prize money will be as follows:**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Prize: Rs 1500
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize: 1000
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Prize: 500

**Prize money for nukkad natak will be**

- 1<sup>st</sup> team – Rs. 7000
- 2nd team- Rs. 5000
- 3rd Team- Rs. 3500

**Participation certificates will be given to all the participants.**

**Organizers will provide:**

- Allowances: Outstation participants/Attendees: ₹1000/day for lodging, 3-tier AC train fare or bus fare, Local participants/Attendees: ₹100/day for travel
- Lunch and snacks
- Conference kits
