

ABOUT VIVEKANANDA COLLEGE

Vivekananda College started in 1970 in a school building with approximately students. The present building was dedicated by Swami Ranganatha Nanda of Ramakrishna Mission in 1979. This college has witnessed a meteoric rise in the number of students seeking admission in different predominantly, courses, Humanities, Commerce, and Social Sciences. GUIDELINES FOR PAPER SUBMISSION

- Abstract should be not more that 300 words
- The word limit for the entire paper should not exceed more than 3000-3500 words
- The Title page should contain the following things: Title, Author(s), Designation, Professional affiliation & Contact Details
- Font Style used for an English paper should be 'Times New Roman" and in case of a Hindi Paper it should be "Unicode Compliant Mangal"
- The Font size used should be 12
- The line spacing should be 1.5
- Document size should be A4
- Margin should be 'I on all sides'
- The reference table or graphs, if used by the candidate, should be Standard APA format.

Final Paper submission must accompany a certificate by the author (s) that the paper is an original piece of work and has neither been published nor submitted for publication elsewhere.
